Posts – (if written)

- Up to 800 words max.
- Write in English or Dutch
- Give your post a short title that grabs attention
- Get to the point
- Use shorter sentences
- Refrain from jargon/overly academic wording
- Use visuals where relevant (photo, graphics, etc)

Topic – anything to do with language/linguistics

- Something language/linguistics-related that is in the news
- Your fieldwork, methodology
- Your research project, paper (or somebody else's), PhD, etc
- A language/linguistics-related event (content, no advertising)
- ...

Blog post types

- Column
- Opinion piece
- Interview
- Review (publication, book)
- Vlog
- ...
